CHALLENGE- WHOSE IS IT?

Learning points:

Sometimes we don't know people as well as we think we do and with the focus so often being on what we look like, we miss so much about learning who people really are, what talents they have and what makes them THEM. In today's social media obsessed world, how could you tell the world more about who you are? Outside of what you look like

How to play:

- Give each young person a piece of paper and have them fill the page with drawings of things they like and/or things that are important to them.
- Ask them to make sure they work individually and that they draw a minimum of 5 things.
- Allow 5 minutes or so for the young people to complete their drawings. Then collect all the pages up and shuffle them.
- Go through each page, one at a time, showing them to the group so that everyone can see what's been drawn/written on the page.
- The aim is to see if the group can guess which page belongs to which person!
