NEW PLACE, SAME RULES

We want you to have loads of fun during our digital drop-in session, but to do that we need to make sure that everyone is following the same rules. Just like we do at regular drop-in, we will expect you to treat others and yourself with respect. We know that you are able to behave responsibly and follow instructions, so we will expect this of you at every session. We want to make this a safe place where everyone feels welcome. This means there will be no swearing or unkind language at any time during these drop in sessions. If we felt that these rules have been broken and a line has been crossed, we will give you a warning. If this happens again we will ask you to leave the digital drop-in for the remainder of the session. If we do this, it's not because you aren't welcome, (you are always welcome at Youthscape), it's just that the behaviour we have seen isn't. However, just like before, we would love to welcome you back next time, and our door is always open (except during COVID-19... but you know what we mean). Our digital drop-in has always been a home-from-home, and a place of love, care and safety, and we want this to continue now that drop-in has become digital. We want you to enjoy yourselves, so the most important rules are these: be yourself, have fun, and know that we are always so pleased to see you!



We will be using an online video calling service called Zoom. You will not need to make an account, instead, at the start of each session your mentor will email you a link to the mentoring online video call. You do NOT need to make your own zoom account.



Everything you share during the digital drop-in sessions will be confidential, this means we promise to keep what you share private, but not secret. We will always have at least two safe adults in the digital drop-in at all times. If we felt you, or someone else, was at risk based on what you share, we would need to pass this information on. We would only do this on a 'need to know' basis. If this ever were the case, we would always aim to tell you before passing the information along, and would bring you into this process as much as possible.
